



Exhibitor Terms and Conditions for Cowdray Park Polo Club

1. Definitions

- "Organizer" refers to the entity responsible for the management of the event.
- "Exhibitor" refers to any company or individual who has secured a space at the event.
- "Event" refers to the CPPC event listed on the booking confirmation, including all related activities.

2. Application and Acceptance

- All applications for exhibit space must be submitted via the official booking form.
- The Organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any application at their discretion.

3. Payment Terms

- A non-refundable deposit is required upon acceptance of the application.
- Full payment must be completed by the specified deadline.
- Late payments may result in loss of retail space.

4. Space Allocation

- Space allocation is at the discretion of the Organizer and will be communicated prior to the event.
- The Organizer reserves the right to change the allocated space if necessary.

5. Exhibit Standards

- Exhibitors must adhere to all safety and building regulations.
- Display structures must not exceed specified height limits and must be safely installed to withstand weather conditions.
- The Organizer may inspect all exhibits for compliance.

6. Insurance and Liability

- Exhibitors are required to carry their own liability insurance.
- The Organizer will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to exhibitor property.

7. Cancellation and Withdrawal

- Cancellations must be submitted in writing.
- Bookings are non-refundable except in such circumstances where the event is cancelled or rescheduled. Should this occur a full refund will be issued to the exhibitor.

8. Event Conduct

- Exhibitors must conduct themselves in a professional manner.



- Noise levels from displays and presentations should not disrupt neighbouring exhibitors.
- Solicitation outside designated areas is prohibited.

9. Compliance with Laws

- Exhibitors must comply with all local, and national laws and regulations.
- All necessary permits must be obtained by the exhibitor.

10. Force Majeure

- The Organizer is not liable for failure to hold the event due to circumstances beyond their control, such as natural disasters or government actions.

11. Governing Law

- These terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of the jurisdiction where the event is held.

12. Amendments

- The Organizer reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time.
- All amendments will be communicated to the exhibitors in a timely manner.
